

Cybersecurity Compliance with Global Regulations

This course familiarizes users with global regulations governing cybersecurity. It covers prominent international laws for the United States, European Union, United Kingdom, China, Japan, Canada, Mexico, UAE, and Saudi Arabia. In addition, the course will review cross border transfer mechanisms, prominent transfer mechanisms for EU-US and Swiss-US, as well as APEC.
